- Follow-up and monitoring of sample collection through the online platform.


# **Selection process:**

- **Deadline:** applications may be submitted up to and including 30<sup>th</sup> September.
- Admission and selection process:
  - The Principal Investigator of the project, Dr Ramon Escuriet, along with the Research Institute of the Faculty of Health Sciences Blanquerna URL, we be responsible for the entire admission and selection process in accordance with the rules and procedures applicable to the entity.
  - The selection process will be carried out in a single phase of curricular evaluation in which the received curricula will be evaluated with the following weighting:

Expedient: 10 points
Knowledge: 30 points
Languages: 30 points
Experience: 30 points
