Profile requirements:

 Education: Higher education training in telecommunications and computer systems or Degree in Health Sciences. Training in digital health will be positively valued

- Admission and selection process:
 - The Principal Investigator of the project, Dr Jordi Vilaró, along with the Research Institute of the Faculty of Health Sciences Blanquerna – URL, we be responsible for the entire admission and selection process in accordance with the rules and procedures applicable to the entity.
 - The selection process will be carried out in a single phase of curricular evaluation in which the received curricula will be evaluated with the following weighting:

Expedient: 25 points
Knowledge: 40 points
Languages: 15 points
Experience: 20 points
